Chart 1. Is the description of the powers/functions of the institution published?





Chart 2. Are the Structural Regulations of the institution published online?

Chart 3. Is a list of the administrative services provided by the institution published online?





Chart 4. Are the internal rules for the provision of administrative services published?

Chart 5. Is the structure of the administration published online?




Chart 6. Is there information about civil servants' competitive examinations?




Chart 7. Is there a Contacts Section?





Chart 8. What type of information is published?

Chart 9. Is there a description of the registers and datasets maintained by the institution?




Chart 10. Are registers maintained by the institution available on the web site?
